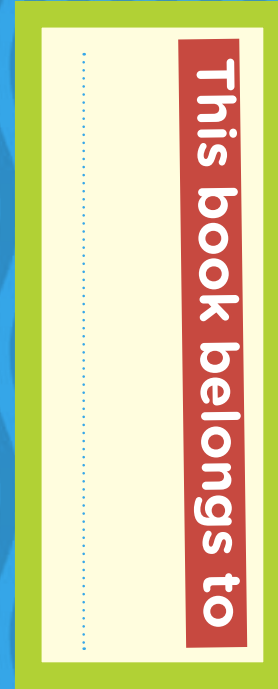

YOU WILL NEED:

- Scissors
- A stapler
- 3 sheets of 8.5"x11" paper

1. Cut out the colored book cover pattern.
2. Stack three sheets of 8.5"x11" paper.
3. Fold the stack in half by folding over once from the top.
4. Fold the stack into quarters by folding over once from the left. The size should now be 4.25"x5.5".
5. Wrap the colored cover around the papers to create a book cover.
6. Carefully use a stapler to staple the cover to the pages along the crease.
7. Use scissors to cut the top fold of the interior pages so there are now 12 interior pages. Trim edges if necessary.
8. Jot down summer memories in your new journal!

YOU WILL NEED:

- Scissors
- Hole punch
- Yarn or elastic
- Decorating supplies like markers or stickers

1. Glue the page to a piece of cardstock for stability.
2. Cut out the yellow visor shape.
3. Use a hole punch to punch out the blue circles.
4. String yarn or elastic through each of the holes and secure with knots.
5. Decorate with scrapbook stickers, markers or glitter!
6. Wrap the loose yarn ends around your head and secure by tying a bow.



fold a breezy origami fan!

1. Cut out the colored square.
2. Fold one edge of the paper into a 1-inch section with a fold facing upward.
3. Flip the paper so the last fold is facing down and fold another 1-inch section.
4. Keep flipping and folding along the entire square until you are done.
5. Pinch one end of the gathered folds and staple or tape the end.
6. Fan out the opposite end and wave the fan in the wind to cool off!

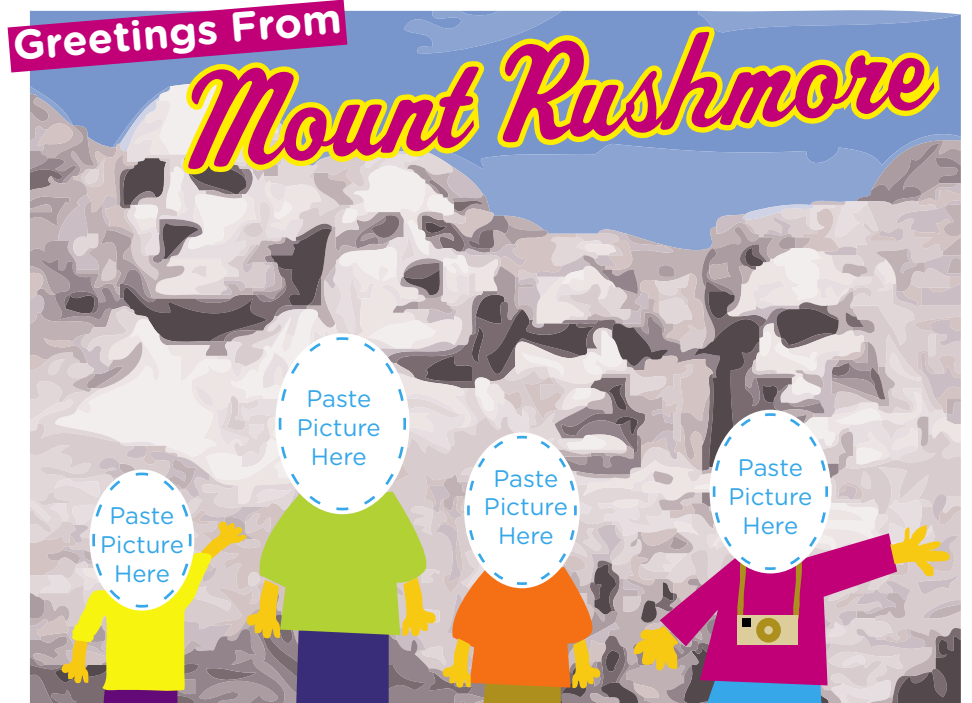
pinwheel!

Pomegranate Cooler



3 cups pomegranate juice, chilled
1/4 cup fresh lime juice
3 cups ginger ale, chilled
Ice

Stir together the pomegranate juice and lime juice in a pitcher. Just before serving, stir in the ginger ale. Pour into glasses filled with ice and garnish with lime slices. Serves 6.

Classic Lemonade



8 lemons
8 cups water
1 1/2 cups sugar
Ice

Juice fresh lemons and stir juice into a pitcher of water. Add sugar and stir until dissolved. Serve over ice. Serves 8.

Root Beer Float



2 scoops of vanilla ice cream
1 can or bottle root beer
1 dollop whipped cream
1 maraschino cherry

Place 1 scoop of ice cream into a tall glass. Pour root beer carefully over the ice cream. Add another scoop and pour more root beer. Top with whipped cream and a cherry. Serves 1.

8. Repeat stringing straw pieces and flowers until the yarn is full.
