

A Few Tips on Using Perusall

- Use the @ sign when referring to a user. They will receive a notification of your comment.
- Be sure to use a question mark when asking questions to receive notifications when a user responds to them.
- Encourage students to create and use hashtags to identify concepts, rhetorical strategies, figurative language, etc. All users can search for comments containing a given hashtag by clicking the hashtag in the hashtag section. Each comment can be visited in context by clicking on the arrow icon.
- Use the Confusion Report and student questions to identify topics or content students may need clarified.
- While Perusall offers automatic grading options, students can copy and paste their comments from another website. Therefore, you may still need to spot check.
- Textbooks are less expensive on Perusall than in print. One Botany textbook whose print version cost \$160, was available in digital form for \$50 on Perusall.
